1. Cape Porpoise Pier Budget Lee presented the budget for review and discussion. While there was general agreement amongst committee that it was a reasonable overall, specific questions and areas of concern persisted. General discussion to increase operational efficiency continues. It was noted that the committee traditionally is involved earlier in the Pier Budget process.

2. Baitshed Discussion concerning a more efficient baitshed / baitspace operating system. Committee agrees to gather thoughts and place then issue on the May 28 meeting agenda.

3. Parking lot Discussion of how to deal with limited parking, satisfy needs of the commercial fleet, while accommodating visitors. Issue tabled for further discussion.
